- Keep any absence to a minimum and within the school's guidelines on absence and illness.
- Support my child in his/her learning in any way I can, especially by ensuring homework is completed and by checking and signing the planner.
- Support the school's Respect Agenda and policies on behaviour, accepting that there may be occasions when sanctions and punishments are necessary.
- Share with the school any information which may affect my child's work, progress or behaviour.
- Attend Parents' Evenings and any other meeting to which I am invited, to discuss my child's work, progress or behaviour.
